## Mini Mosaic Quilt Supply List

## Overall size of finished quilt 13 x 13"

- Portable ironing board (minimum 12") used to pin the pattern & fusible onto in order to assemble our tiles –
  another option is to cut foam core display board to size and tape two layers together around its perimeter.
- o 10 ½ " x 10 ½ " square of **sticky fusible** (I used Steam a Seam 2 with 2 paper backings) You can tape two 8 ½ x 11 backing sheets together and trim to size.
- Tweezers that grip when you release pressure, pointy like scrapbook enthusiasts use HIGHLY SUGGESTED
- Applique pressing sheet and/or parchment paper
- Rotary cutting mat to accommodate quilt
- Rotary cutter
- o Rulers (12" or 24" by whatever you possess will work) If you have a square 12 x 12, great
- o Pins, scissors, neutral thread, sewing basics
- Loyalty card or expired gift card to scoop up mosaic tiles easily
- o Iron we can share these
- Sewing machine with walking foot if available

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## **Fabrics:**

\*I will cut up *donated* BATIK fabrics to 3/8" squares to use. They will be available by color family on the day of class. Please drop off your offerings to me at the Quilt Show table. The more variety dropped off the better the quilt possibilities. 4" x 4" is an easy size for me to cut up and have available for you on class day.

- o Backing Fabric -13 x 13 (or larger if you want to wrap backing fabric around to front as your binding)
- o **Grout** Fabric: Bring several possible fabrics light to dark to be used as 'grout' fabrics approx: 12 x 12" needed. This fabric shows between the batik tiles when layered. (After you have ironed your tiles to your fusible backing, you will be more able to determine what you like best with the tile colors you selected during class)
- o **2 Border Fabrics** I had no clue what I would use before I selected my tiles, so if you bring several choices of materials to audition and then cut, this would be my suggestion.
  - o Inner 2 (1" x 11"), 2 –( 1" x 12") ( I selected a darker shade and only ¼" will remain of this color)
  - Outer − 2 − (1 ½" x 12"), 2 − (1 ½" x 14)
- o Batting low loft (14 x 14 remnant)
- o **Binding fabric** straight of grain will work for this small quilt. 54" x 1 ¾". I used Edyta Sitar's suggested binding technique to reduce the bulk. I will explain this method to you during class.
