Fat Quarters (18" x 21")*	12 Fat quarters
Background	3 yds.
Backing	4 yds.

### Lupine

Assorted Fat Quarters	5 FQ's	9 FQ's	11 FQ's	12 FQ's
Background	3-1/3 yds.	4-1/3 yds.	5-3/4 yds.	6-3/4 yds.
