

Beeswax food storage pouches and wraps

Are you looking for ways to reduce the amount of plastic in your life? Trying to find reusable food storage solutions that actually *work*? Join Cathy to learn how to take a single yard of fabric and turn it into different-sized food storage units. You'll cut and sew your fabric in class, dip it in beeswax, and leave with 7 different food wraps, completed and ready to use. Use a fabric that matches your own kitchen décor or make extras to keep on hand for gifts! You will have time to make several sets in class, or after finishing a set, you may want to drop-in to any of the charity sewing areas happening all day in the main room.

There will be a \$3 per yard fee payable to instructor, to cover the cost of the beeswax she will supply.

**Supply List for Beeswax food wraps and pouches**

One yard of fabric *for each set* of 7 wraps

Rotary cutter

24" ruler

Mat

Sewing machine in working order

Basic sewing supplies

You will have time to make multiple sets.

If you DO decide to bring more than a single yard of fabric, please let us know when you sign up, so the instructor has sufficient wax for all participants.

You may choose to prewash and press your fabric. That is a personal decision and is completely up to you. (Cathy does NOT prewash her fabric.)
