

Anxiety- Free Color Theory

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Does choosing the 'right' fabric for your project overwhelm you? Are you prone to buying kits so you just don't have to stress yourself about what 'goes' with what? Then this class is for you!!

Join Theresa for a short lecture about color theory in general, followed by an open discussion about color choices specifically for quilters. Highlights include a PowerPoint presentation of color theory and a demonstration of how to use color to create the look you want in your quilts. Theresa will share how she organizes her own stash. She'll show you several color 'recipes' to guarantee success, and then share some unexpected tools for finding that right 'look' for your next project.

After the lecture, you will begin making a color wheel of your own, using 'real-world' fabrics - INCLUDING PRINTS – from your own stash. This will accomplish two goals:

- Making the decisions about which fabric belongs where on the color wheel will help cement color theory in your own skills toolbox, and
- Having the color wheel in your sewing room will aid in your future success.

Note: Your color wheel will be started in class, but you will finish it at home. Theresa will supply white felt for the background. There will be a nominal fee of \$1 per student for the felt, payable in class to the instructor.

Supply list for Anxiety-Free Color Theory

Fabric scraps in a variety of colors. From your stash, bring pieces at least 2" to 4" square, in prints or solids, to use and to share with others.
