What is a mug rug? Well, it's not a coaster and it's not a placemat. It is somewhere in between. [The Patchsmith Blog](#) says, "a mug rug usually accommodates a mug and a cake or cookies. A mug rug is a mini quilt varying in size from 4" x 7" to as large as 12" x 8."



Our next member activity will be a mug rug swap. Here's how it works...

- ❖ Participants must be willing to mail the mug rug they made to their "swapee".
- ❖ Mug Rugs can be between 4" x6" -ish to 6" x10" -ish. They do not have to be rectangular. There are lots of mug rug ideas and free patterns online.
- ❖ Participants will fill out the online form below no later than Sunday, October 18th. I will send you an email with your "swapee" and the information they provided by Wednesday, October 21th.
- ❖ Mug Rugs should be completed and mailed no later than Thursday, November 12th.
