

## **Warm & Wooly Welcome Class Supply and Prep List**

For the class, we will be working on the seasonal panels. We will probably only have time to work on one in class so choose the one you want to get done first. You do not have to cut out the pieces for the wall hanging base before class unless you want to.

1. **Warm & Wooly Welcome template pages (provided by designer to program chair). Whole pattern will be provided in class as part of the class fee.**

**Copy the template pages of the pattern and cut out template pieces. You can reinforce these pieces by gluing the pages to a piece of card stock or other stiff material before cutting them out on the lines.**

### **Fabric & Wool**

2. **For this class we will be working on wool appliqué on the seasonal panels so you only need to cut a fabric piece for one (or more) of the panels.**
3. **Choose which seasonal panel you want to work on in class and bring the wool scraps needed for that panel.**

### **Supplies Needed:**

1. **Lightweight fusible web (such as Heat n Bond Light) and pencil for tracing around templates.**

2. **Additional supplies needed:**

**\*Fabric scissors and paper scissors**

**\*Wool Appliqué needles (I use John James size 22 or 24 chenille needles),**

**\*Embroidery floss or Perle cotton (no.8) in a neutral color or various colors if you want to match the wool appliqué pieces if you want your stitches to blend in.**

**\*Fabric glue such as Roxanne's Glue Baste-it.**

**\*Fray Check (optional) to reinforce edges of background fabric.**

**\*Fabric marking pencil such as Sewline™.**

**\*Rulers**

**I will have some of these items for sale in class.**

**\*\* Be sure to put your name on all of your supplies that you bring to class.**

## Prep for Class:

1. Cut a rectangle of fabric from a tan print: 15 x 20". This will be used as the background for the seasonal panel you make in class (no need to cut fabric if you purchased a kit).
2. Reinforce templates to prepare them for tracing.
3. Gather the wool needed to make your chosen panel (no need if you purchased a kit). Below are the wool pieces needed for each seasonal panel:

**Spring:** 7 1/2 x 6 1/2" piece medium grey (container), 1 1/2 x 6 1/2" piece light blue (container), 3 x 12" piece medium brown (stems), 5 x 5" piece pink (letters), 3 assorted 2 1/2 x 4" pieces (flowers), 2 assorted 5 x 6" pieces of green (leaves), 3 x 3" white (star), 5 x 5" piece dark red (berries), 5 assorted 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" scraps (pennies), assorted scraps for flower centers, star center and small pennies.

**Summer:** 5 1/2 x 8 1/2" piece dark red (house), 3 x 8" piece light yellow (sun), 3 x 9" piece light gold (sun), 5 x 8" piece medium gold (flowers), 3 1/2 x 5 1/2" white (sheep), 4 x 5" piece medium purple (letters), 3 x 10" piece light green (stems & calyxes), 3 x 5" piece dark green (leaves), 7 x 7" piece black (roof, windows, chimney & sheep), 7 assorted 2 1/4 x 2 1/4" pieces (large tongues), 2 1/4 x 2 1/4" piece dark brown (flower center), assorted scraps for star and small tongues.

**Fall:** 4 x 7" piece medium orange (large pumpkin), 3 x 5" dark orange ( med. pumpkin), 2 x 2" piece light orange (small pumpkin), 6 x 7" piece dark gold (letters), 6 x 6" piece medium brown (basket & handle), 2 x 5 1/2" black (crow), 1 1/2 x 9" piece dark blue (bottom bar), 1 x 7" piece dark brown (long stems), 5 assorted 2 1/4 x 2 1/4" pieces (large pennies), 3 x 4" piece med. green ( pumpkin leaves), assorted scraps for fall leaves, small pennies, pumpkin stems, basket button and star.

**Winter:** 5 1/2 x 8 1/2" piece med. Brown (house), 6 x 14" piece dark green (tree), 7 x 6" piece of white (snow & snowflakes), 1 1/4 x 13 1/2" grey (bottom bar), 2 1/2 x 6" dark brown (roof & chimney), 1 1/2 x 4 1/2" piece dark brown #2 (tree trunk), 5 x 6" piece med. blue (letters), 2 1/2 x 7" black (stems and windows), 2 assorted 3 1/2 x 5" pieces of green (holly leaves), 3 x 3" piece dark gold (large star), assorted scraps for large and small pennies, small stars, wreath and berries.
