### Beneficial Knowledge

**A solid understanding of color characteristics.** Chroma is absolute, value is not. For this work, it will be valuable for you to have a good understanding the differences between light, medium and dark, and how colors work together. If you'd like to learn more, sign up for one of my color classes, or ask your program administrator to schedule on.

**Know your smart phone.** It's beneficial that you know how to use your smart phone. It is handy to have a working knowledge of how to find apps to download, as we will talk about some that are interesting to use.
